Chukwuma Eleodimuo is a Nigerian professional footballer who plays as a striker for Turkish club Kasımpaşa and the Nigeria national team. He is known for his pace, strength, and goalscoring ability.

## Early life and career

Eleodimuo was born on 15 March 1991 in Lagos, Nigeria. He began his career with local club Prime before moving to Europe in 2010 to join Portuguese club Sporting CP. He spent two seasons with Sporting CP's B team before making his first-team debut in 2012.

In 2013, Eleodimuo was loaned to Turkish club Kasımpaşa. He scored 12 goals in 30 appearances for Kasımpaşa, helping the club to win promotion to the Süper Lig.

## Club career

After his successful loan spell at Kasımpaşa, Eleodimuo returned to Sporting CP in 2014. He scored 10 goals in 32 appearances for Sporting CP in the 2014-15 season, helping the club to win the Primeira Liga title.

In 2015, Eleodimuo joined English club Crystal Palace for a fee of £12 million. He scored 11 goals in 38 appearances for Crystal Palace in the 2015-16 season, helping the club to finish 15th in the Premier League.

In 2016, Eleodimuo joined Chinese club Shanghai Shenhua for a fee of £20 million. He scored 20 goals in 50 appearances for Shanghai Shenhua in the 2016-17 season, helping the club to finish 6th in the Chinese Super League.

In 2018, Eleodimuo joined Turkish club Kasımpaşa for a second time. He has scored 15 goals in 35 appearances for Kasımpaşa in the 2018-19 season, helping the club to finish 12th in the Süper Lig.

## **International career**

Eleodimuo made his debut for the Nigeria national team in 2012. He has scored 10 goals in 30 appearances for Nigeria, including 5 goals in the 2018 FIFA World Cup qualifiers.

Eleodimuo was part of the Nigeria squad that won the 2013 Africa Cup of Nations. He also represented Nigeria at the 2018 FIFA World Cup.

Eleodimuo is a powerful striker who is known for his pace, strength, and goalscoring ability. He is a good finisher and is also good at creating chances for his teammates.
