
I am so grateful for the opportunity to cover the Baltimore Ravens. It is an honor to be a part of this team, and I am excited to see what the future holds for us.

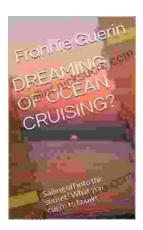
