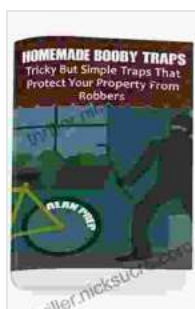

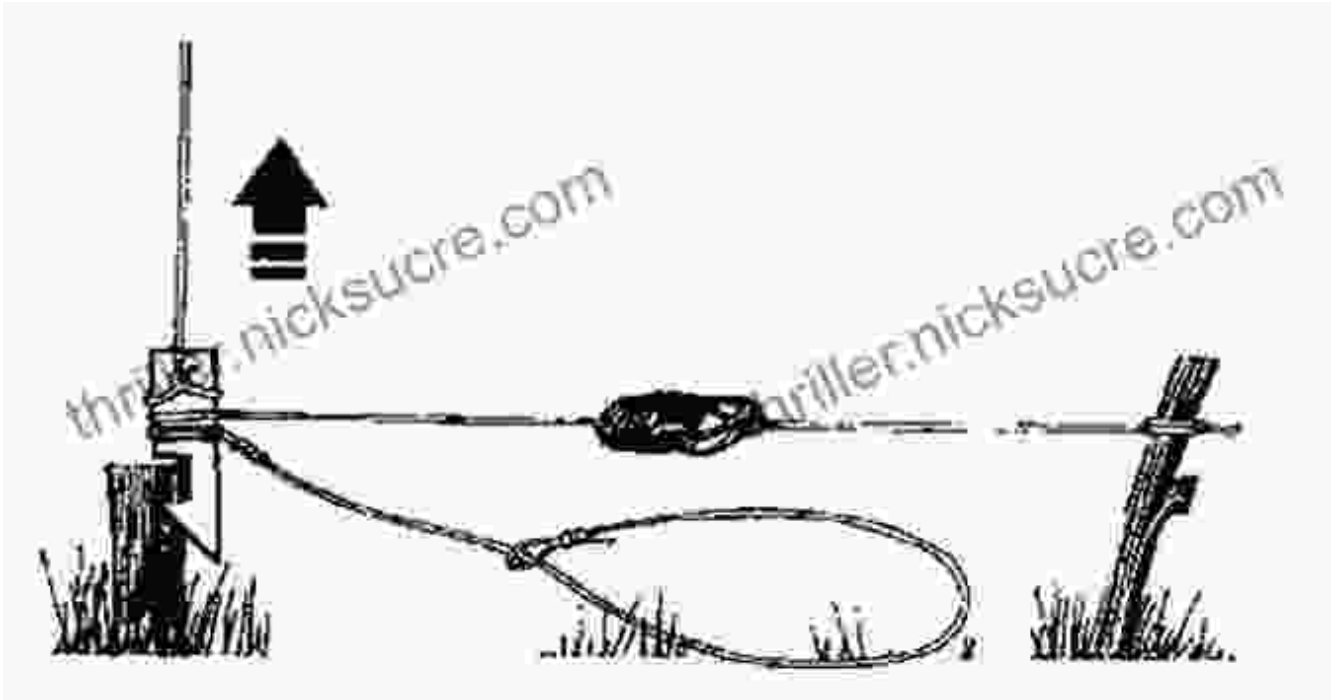

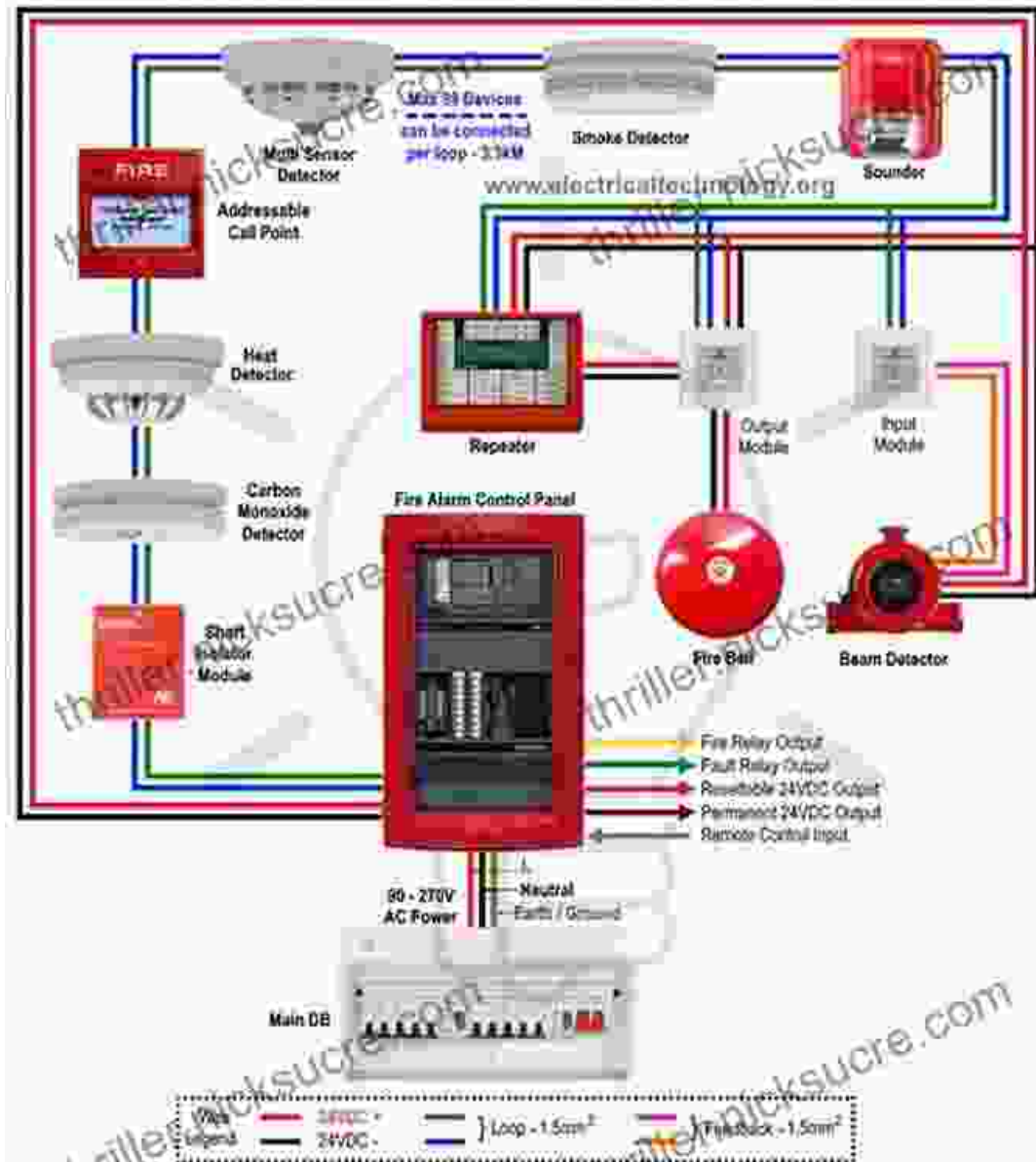


The string trap is a simple and effective way to deter burglars.

2. The Tin Can Alarm

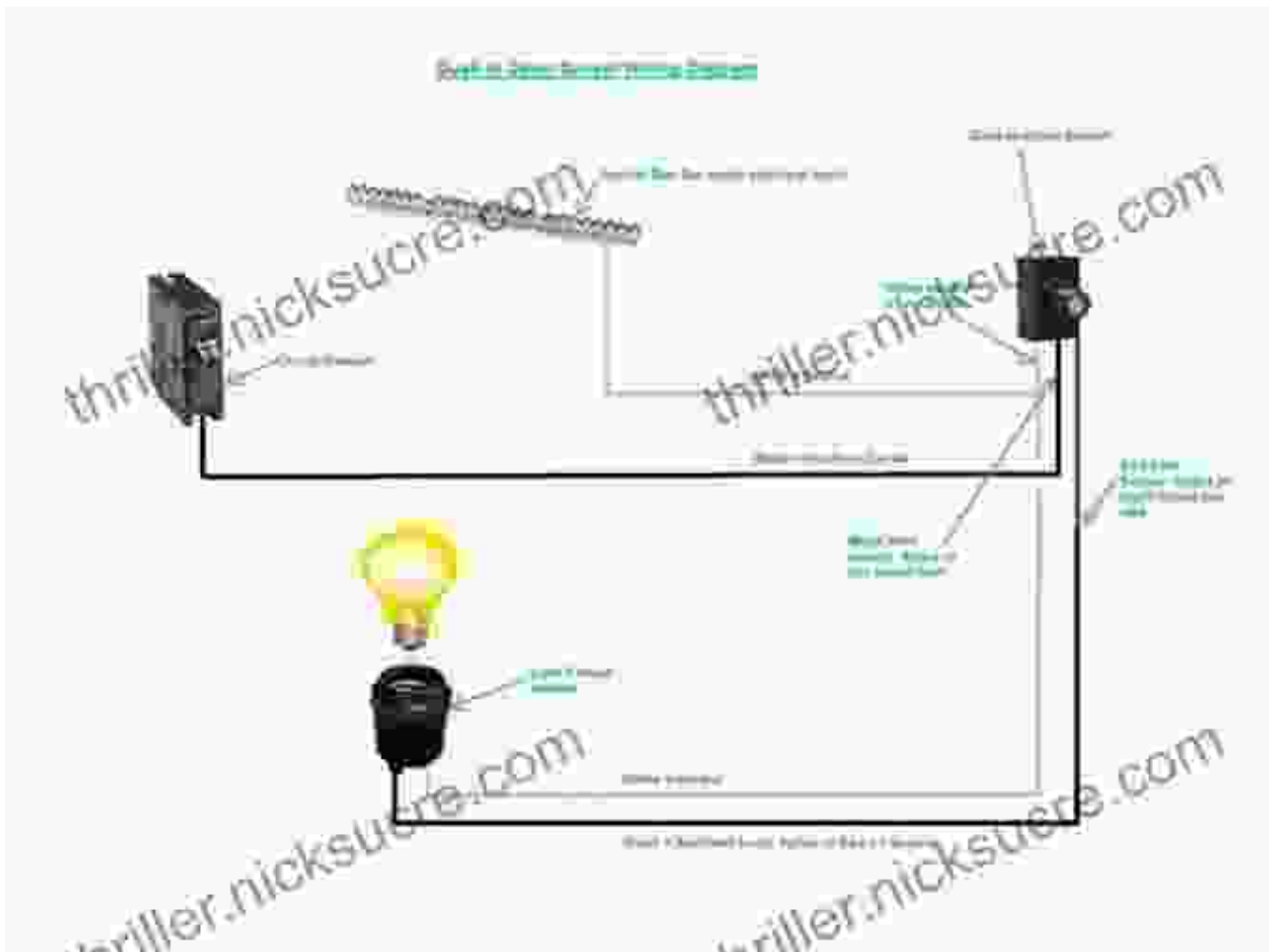

3. The Motion Detector

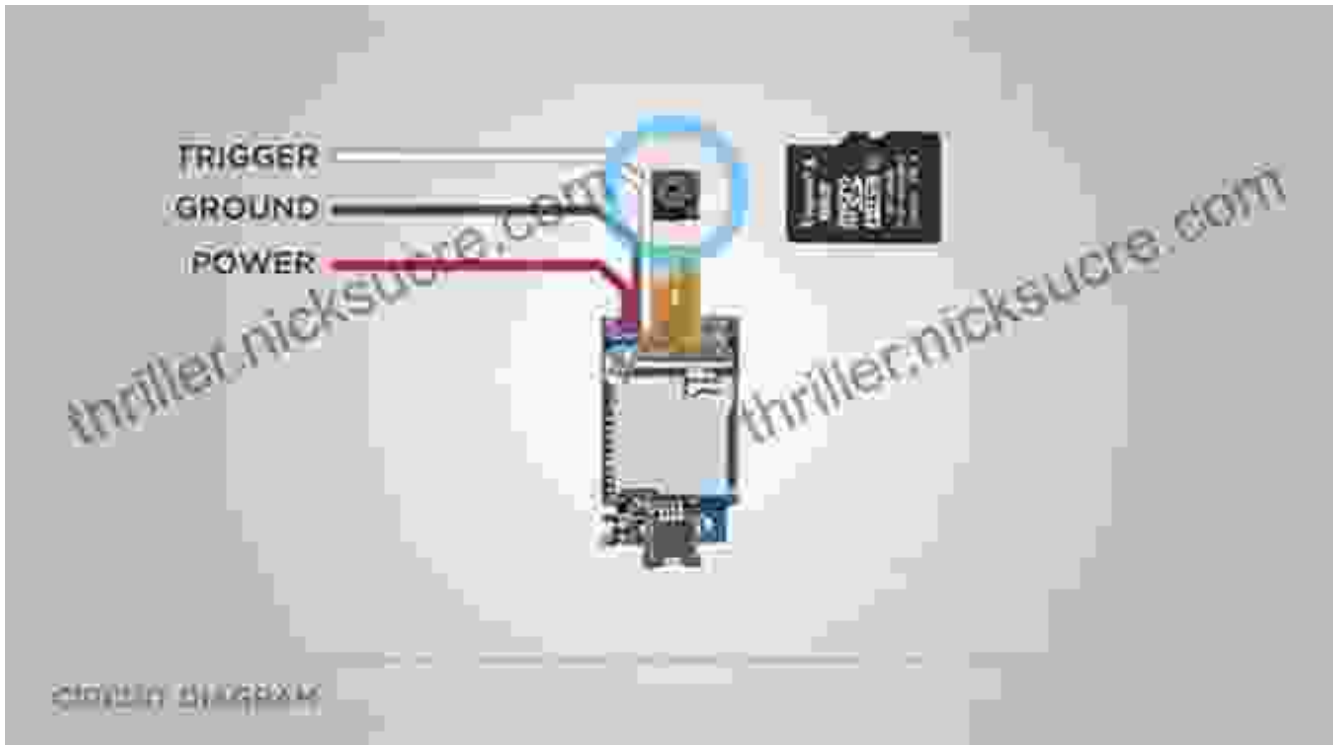

Motion detectors can be used to protect doors and windows.

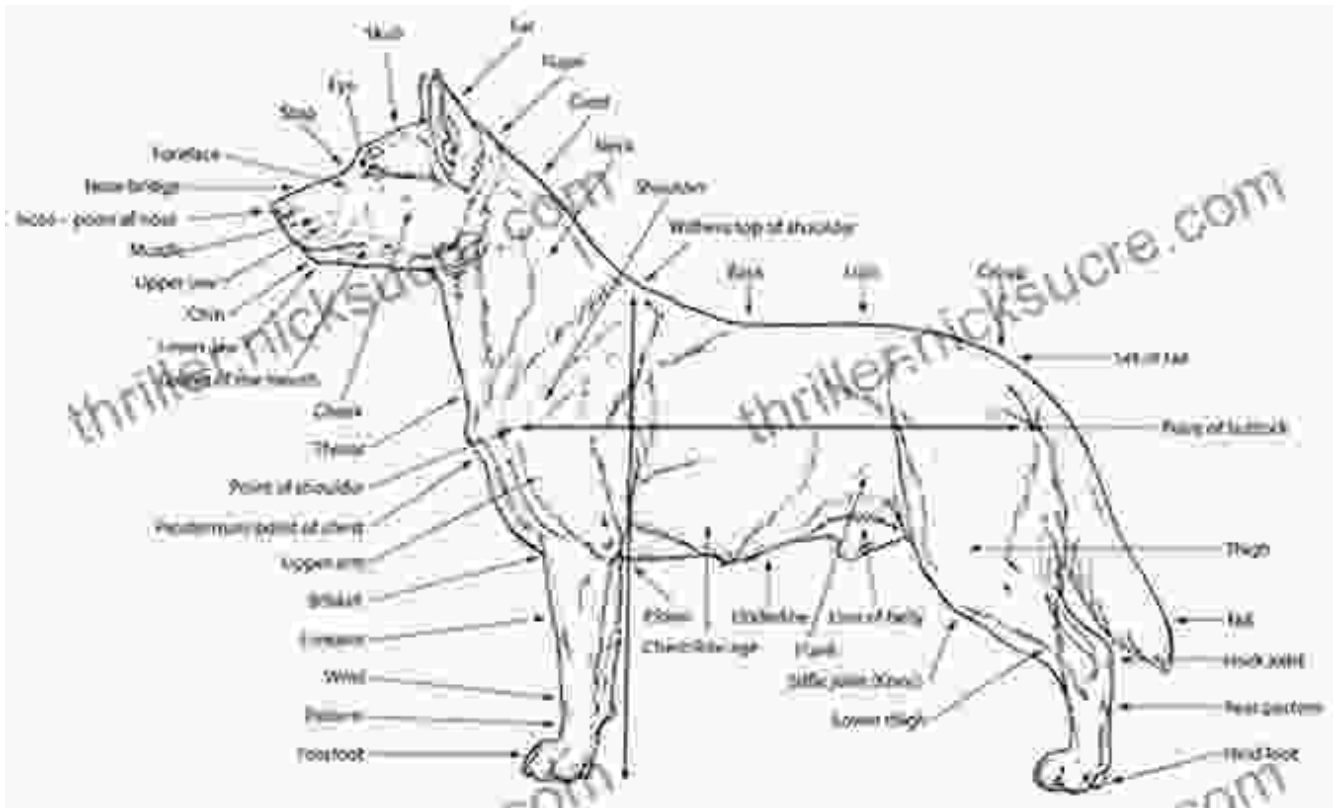
4. The Hidden Camera

Fake dogs can scare away burglars.

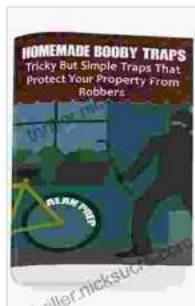

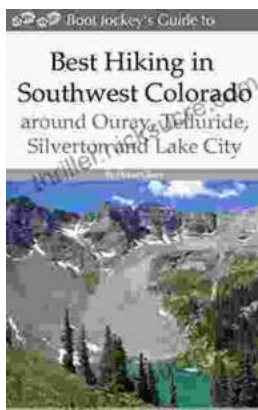

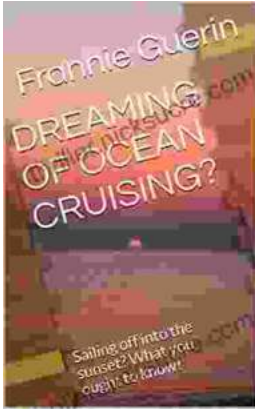
