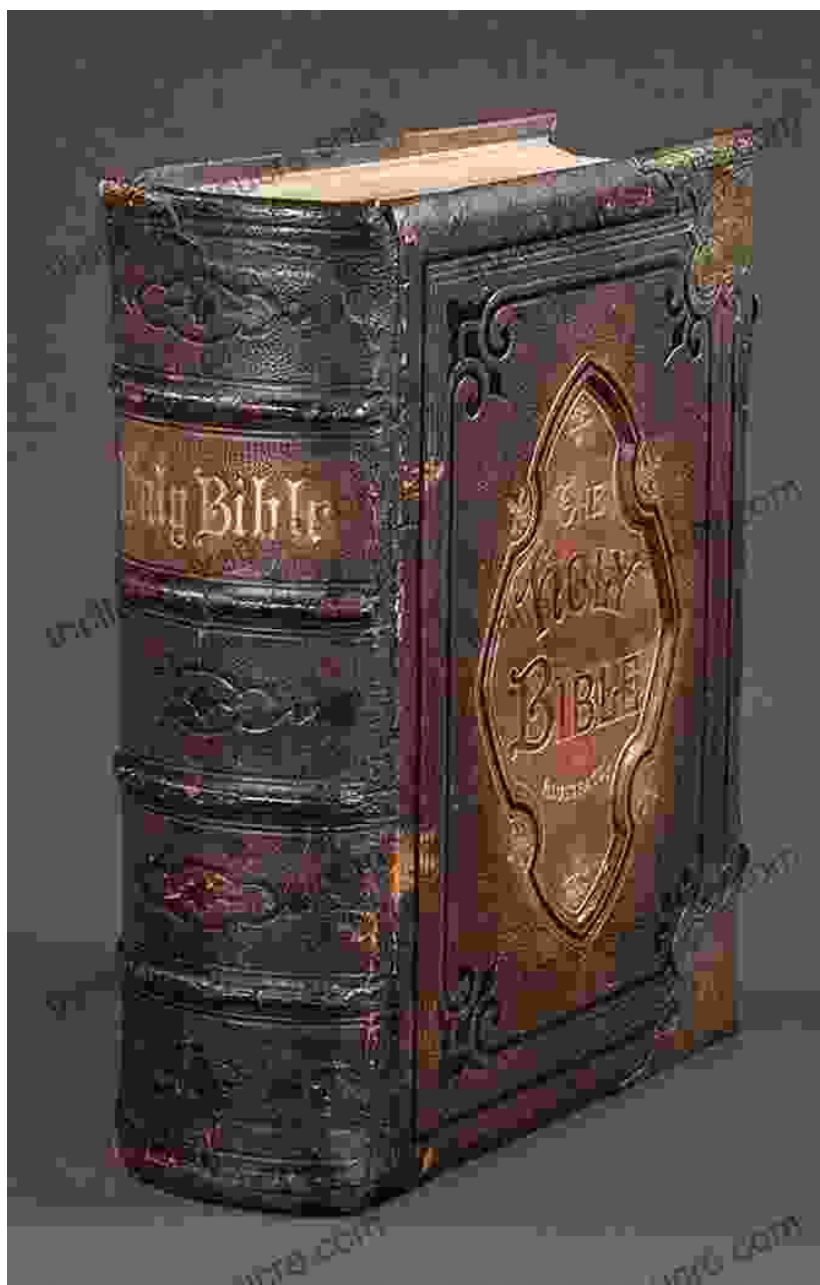
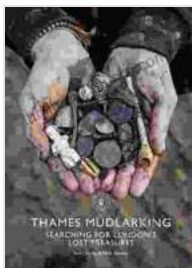
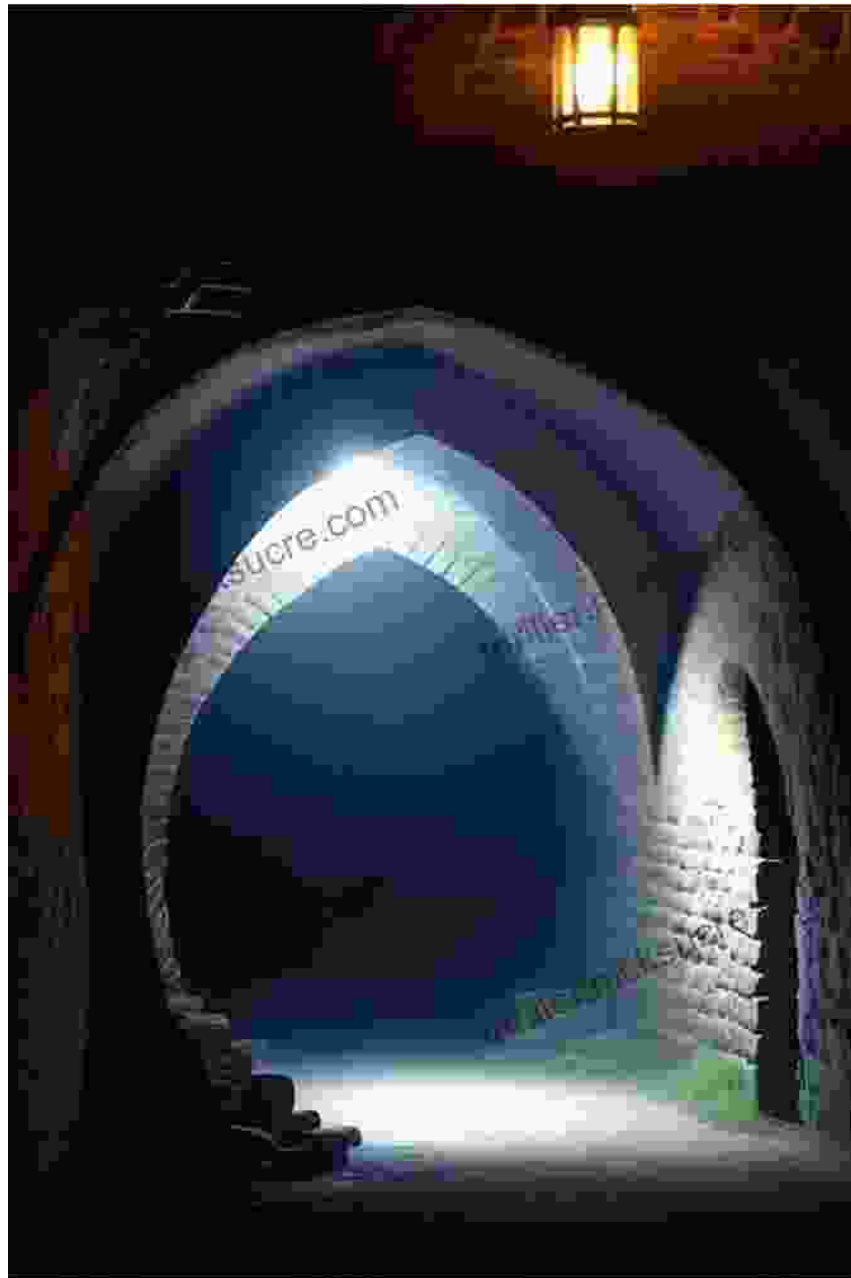


Figure 5: A map of the Templars' treasure

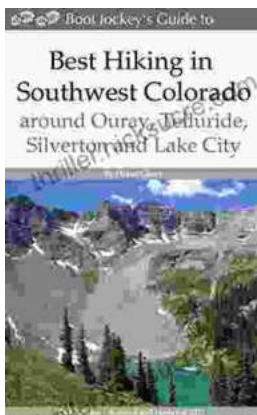

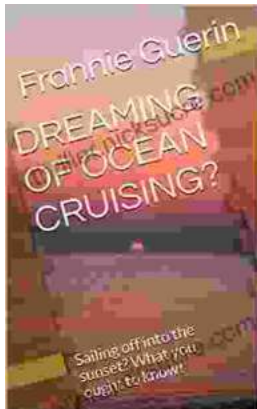
